Wind Power

Rane Group avails wind power from 13 Nos. Wind Energy Generators having a total installed capacity of 7.660 MW for its various manufacturing Units within Tamilnadu. The wind power constitutes approximately 25% of the total electricity requirements of these units.



Reduction of Carbon Footprint

A Pilot study was undertaken through an external Consultant to estimate the carbon footprint generated by one of the Group's manufacturing facilities in Chennai. The study threw up some interesting data on how carbon footprint is generated at all levels and how even small measures could lead up to reduction in carbon footprint. The results of the pilot study are being used to create awareness among the employees across the group on the subject and encourage them to adopt measures that would help reduce carbon footprint.

Green Building Certification

Rane Institute for Employee Development (RIED) located at Perungudi on the Old Mahabalipuram Road, Chennai is a LEED silver certified Green Building.

Rane Polytechnic Technical Campus (RPTC) under construction in Tiruchirapalli is also likely to get green certification.
