Market Commentary

- The growth in PV segment was driven by strong performance of new models in UV
- CV industry performance led by growth in M&HCV segment
- The drop in Farm tractor segment is due to decreased monsoon activity and subdued market sentiments.
- Demand from international markets remained favourable across product categories








> Sales increased by 15.8% from Rs. 1,639.2 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 1,897.5 Cr in Q2 FY24

- Revenue from Indian OE customers grew 16% supported by strong growth across vehicle segments
- Revenues from International customers increased 20% driven by higher off-take across steering, valve train, light metal casting and occupant safety products
- Revenue from Indian aftermarket segment increased by 5%

RHL consolidated – Financial Performance Review (Q2 FY24)









- > Total Revenue increased by 5.3% from Rs. 883.8 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 930.0 Cr in Q2 FY24
- > EBITDA increased by 8.7% from Rs. 66.8 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 72.7 Cr in Q2 FY24
- EBITDA margin increased 25 bps supported by lower material cost and improved operational performance.
- > PAT increased by 119% from Rs.23.3 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 51.1 Cr in Q2 FY24



RML Standalone – Financial Performance Review (Q2 FY24)









> Total Revenue increased by 6.7% from Rs. 537.0 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 572.9 Cr in Q2 FY24

- Sales to Indian OE customers dropped 2% due to decline in Farm Tractors segment and served segment de-growth in PV.
- Sales to International customers grew 31% driven by strong off-take for steering and light metal casting products.
- Sales to Indian Aftermarket customers increased by 7%.

> EBITDA increased by 20.1% from Rs. 43.8 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 52.6 Cr in Q2 FY24

- EBITDA margin increased by 103 bps supported by favourable mix which helped offset the higher employee costs.
- > PAT decreased by 54.3% from Rs. 15.8 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 7.2 Cr in Q2 FY24
- In Q2 FY'24, recorded a fair value loss on overseas investment for Rs. 121.6 Cr and also created a Deferred Tax Asset of Rs. 113.3 Cr.

RML Consolidated – Financial Performance Review (Q2 FY24)









- > Total Revenue increased by 1.9% from Rs. 600.6 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 611.9 Cr in Q2 FY24
- > EBITDA decreased by 3.7% from Rs. 33.8 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 32.5 Cr in Q2 FY24
- > PAT increased from Rs. 0.05 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 17.8 Cr in Q2 FY24
- In Q2 FY'24, recorded a loss on sale of LMCA for Rs. 85.5 Cr and also created a Deferred Tax Asset of Rs. 113.3 Cr.
- > Divestment of its wholly owned subsidiary LMCA completed on 14th September 2023 and accordingly the company has consolidated the financial performance of LMCA till 14th September 2023.





- > Total Revenue increased by 16.5 % from Rs. 123.3 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 143.7 Cr in Q2 FY24
- Sales to Indian OE customers grew by 13% supported by strong offtake across served customers.
- Export Sales grew 25%. Demand from International customers remained strong.
- Sales to Indian Aftermarket customers grew by 14%.
- > EBITDA increased by 11.5% from Rs. 8.3 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 9.2 Cr in Q2 FY24
- EBITDA margin declined by 29 bps. Better operational leverage was offset by higher employee cost
- > PAT increased from a Loss of Rs. 0.04 Cr in Q2 FY23 to a profit of Rs. 1.5 Cr in Q2 FY24





- > Total Revenue increased by 9.3% from Rs. 144.7 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 158.2 Cr in Q2 FY24
- Sales to OE customer grew 13%, which was driven by strong sales to Two wheeler segment.
- Sales to Aftermarket customers grew 4%
- > EBITDA increased by 29.1% from Rs. 13.8 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 17.8 Cr in Q2 FY24
- EBITDA margin improved by 172 bps on account of higher volume and one-off provision reversal during this quarter.
- > PAT increased by 48% from Rs. 6.5 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 9.6 Cr in Q2 FY24





- > Total Revenue increased by 23% from Rs. 449.4 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 552.7 Cr in Q2 FY24
- Revenue from steering gear products increased 20% supported by strong demand from commercial vehicle segment
- Revenue from occupant safety systems grew 27% supported by strong offtake from domestic and export customers
- > EBITDA increased by 16.9% from Rs. 46.6 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 54.4 Cr in Q2 FY24
- EBITDA margin declined by 55 bps due to adverse mix.
- > PAT increased by 1.9% from Rs. 22.9 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 23.4 Cr in Q2 FY24





- The growth in the quarter is on account of lower base due to EOP and higher growth on served models
- > EBITDA increased by 2.1% from Rs. 25.4 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 25.9 Cr in Q2 FY24
- Adverse mix and increase in material cost impacted the profitability
- > PAT increased from Rs. 4.3 Cr in Q2 FY23 to Rs. 9.1 Cr in Q2 FY24
- Exceptional income of Rs. 3 Cr towards sale of scrapped parts.
